<u>Geography</u>

Children will recall the features of the local area and its physical and human geography, they will learn how to locate the key features on a map and how to sequence a journey through the local area. They will also investigate other people's 📠 📭 views of the local area. Children will use their knowledge to compare different natural environments and describe them using key vocabulary.

Science

Animals including humans. This half term we will notice than animals and humans reproduce. We will develop our understanding and describe the basic needs of animals, including humans for survival. We will learn about how the human appearance changes as you grow older as well as identifying the features that will not alter with age.
